JAY SOMMERVILLE CONTEMPORARY ROMANCE SCRIPTING

Story 1: "Between Loyalty and Desire"

Setting: A family dinner in a brownstone in Brooklyn.

Characters:

Emma – A strong, independent woman in her early 30s who's always done the right thing... until now.

Jake – Emma's caring, reliable husband who's comfortable in his own skin.

Ryan – Jake's younger brother, a magnetic and confident man in his mid-20s who just moved back to the city.

Opening Scene: Emma stands at the kitchen island, preparing a meal. She hears laughter coming from the living room, where Jake and Ryan are catching up.

Narration:

Setting: A luxury retreat in Paris with a modern, upscale urban vibe.

Characters:

Characters:
